

How can I build the tests and ignore any errors?

You can run `make check` with the `-i` option to ignore errors.

Alternately, you can set the environment variable `$HDF5_Make_Ignore` to tell the hdf5 Makefile to ignore test errors and continue on. For example:

```
env HDF5_Make_Ignore=yes gmake check
```

When running `make check`, redirect the output to a file.

If a test fails, `make` will print a message (echo `*** Error ignored`) and continue. Therefore, you can search the output for the string "Error ignored" to see if any tests failed.
