H5LT_GET_ATTRIBUTE_LONG

Reads an attribute from disk

Procedure:

H5LT_GET_ATTRIBUTE_LONG (loc_id, obj_name, attr_name, data)

Signature:

```
herr_t H5LTget_attribute_long( hid_t loc_id, const char *obj_name, const char *attr_name, long *data )
```

Parameters:

<i>hid_t</i> loc_id	IN: Identifier of the object (dataset or group) to read the attribute from
<i>const char</i> *obj_name	IN: The name of the object that the attribute is attached to
<i>const char</i> *attr_name	IN: The attribute name
<i>long</i> *data	OUT: Buffer with data

Description:

H5LT_GET_ATTRIBUTE_LONG reads an attribute named `attr_name` that is attached to the object specified by the name `obj_name`. The HDF5 datatype of the attribute is H5T_NATIVE_LONG.

Returns:

Returns a non-negative value if successful; otherwise returns a negative value.
